

RIGHTS OF HUMANITY AND PLANET EARTH A DIALOGUE OF PEACE AND LOVE

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- 1. Humanity has the right for all the people of the planet to unite in a common cause to assure the preservation of life in brotherhood and peace as part of a Universal Culture of Love in harmony with Divine Mother Nature and the Transcendental Consciousness; in other words, one People and one Earth united under God.
- 2. Humanity has the right to enjoy the perfect environment of planet Earth as it was originally created for the perpetual sustenance and flourishing of life, with all the wonder of Mother Nature.
- 3. Humanity, as well as all forms of life, originated from God on Earth. Thus they all have the right to live with full respect for free will and the dignity of the Soul.

- 4. Humanity has the right to the innate wholeness and plenitude that Divine Mother Nature provides with endless love through the land, sea and forests, the natural resources and the elements that hold and revitalize regenerate life on the planet: oxygen, water, biodiversity, fertile soil, and food.
- 5. Humanity has the right to a healthy environment, to a 100% natural and organically grown foods, to clean water, air and atmosphere, free of risk of any contamination, pollution, genetic manipulation or experimentation of plants, animals, bacteria or any type of living organism, radioactive and artificial waves, synthetic chemicals, and whatever activity, (in whatever) scientific or non scientific experimental ways, that might have known or unknown hazards to human beings resulting in violation of the Laws of Nature.

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- 6. Humanity has the right to reliable and undisturbed living conditions free from the potential danger or effects of nuclear plants and fuel, stockpiles or disposal of nuclear waste material, biological, non biological, and nuclear weapons and artillery, machinery and armaments of war, and initiatives to develop new agents, elements, systems or technology with destructive-warfare purposes.
- 7. Humanity has the right to enjoy life free from any violence, crime and conflict forms, whatever they might be of political, social, economical, religious, military or nonmilitary kind, it also has the right to a peaceful solution of differences and problems through dialogue, consensus and reconciliation; without threaten of disrupting stability and continuity of life caused by primitive solving problem methods that lead to unsafe world.
- 8. Humanity has the right that all knowledge from the total spectrum of fields of sciences and technology, at the exclusive service of the general well-being, happiness and spiritual growth, and a human life without poverty and hunger, as well as the preservation, restoration, and protection of Home Planet Earth.

- 9. Humanity has the right to maintain the human body as it was originally created in God's image, free of risk from irreversible, irreparable and immeasurable effects or mutations that can result from experimentation and cloning of living cells because of transgressions of the Laws of Nature.
- 10. Humanity has the right to full transparency and access of information, knowledge, data, or any findings on whatever subject matter or phenomenon; that is, to the truth, the whole truth without secret laws.
- 11. Humanity has the right to be served by citizens with the highest spiritual and moral values, intelligence, knowledge, vision, integrity, and ecological consciousness, proven and verifiable, and whose performance is always based on a code of moral and environmental ethics for the public and private goods, services, and processes.
- 12. Humanity and the Earth have the right to a mutual and reciprocal relationship, as a dynamic and conscientious response to the unconditional love, beauty, nourishment, shelter, and life sustaining elements that Divine Mother Nature has provided to the human race since the beginning of life.

- 13. Planet Earth has the right to restore and repair Mother Nature, as a unique, single, integrated, comprehensive, perfect and fragile ecosystem, from the damages incurred by the neglectful activities of mankind, throughout the centuries, but mainly from the 20th Century until now, such as deforestation, extinction of species of flora and fauna, loss of biodiversity, desertification, soil erosion, dwindling of the ozone layer, climate alterations due to green-house gases, contamination of water sources, air, and land, disposal of general and nuclear waste on land, rivers, lakes, and oceans, and underground explosions for nuclear testing; all for the assurance of survival of the human race and the Earth.

Humanity and Mother Earth have the sacred right to love, be loved, and to exercise the unlimited power of the Soul's love to restore God's original plan of the Garden of Eden for the whole human race and for every corner of the planet, with the Spirit of the Truth and Justice, and the Brotherhood of Light, to live in eternal bliss, as a shining Golden Star.
- 15. Light planet Earth has the right for her own metaphysical evolution jointly and synergistically with the Human Race, as an integrated ascending spiritual unity in the transcendental purpose of life, with God's infinite and omnipresent Love.

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
